FEES: \$70 per player, for Term 2/3 - Invoiced by the school when teams

are confirmed (Payment options available)

UNIFORM: Ross PE T-shirt and Shorts, black socks and sports shoes

EQUIPMENT: Table tennis bat - bats are available for students who don't have

their own. Students should also wear suitable non-marking shoes.

School shoes must not be worn!

SEASON: Where: Barber Hall at Central Energy Trust Arena.

When: Thursday - Starts 2nd May and Finishes on 4th July. (7 playing weeks) No play for everyone on the 30th May & 27th June

Time: Playing times are 3:50-5:45 pm

PLAYING VENUE: Barber Hall at Central Energy Trust Arena.

Teams need to be ready to start at the table no more than 10 minutes after the scheduled time. Venue is open to arrive straight from school.

The first week will be grading matches. This is to ensure each team is placed in the most appropriate grade for their standard. It helps give me an idea on the strength of new players and teams that haven't played before.

Each team should have 3 players in attendance each week. Teams that have less than 3 players will lose half a competition point for each player short they are each week. I encourage to have a few reserve players who could fill in at short notice.
